## **SUBMISSIONS AND GUIDELINES**

All submission of paper should be received before the deadline, 10 December 2006, and the submission must be sent to IBIZ2007@mmu.edu.my. To ensure acceptance of the paper to the proceeding, one of the authors must register to participate in the conference.

### **Submissions Must Follow These Guidelines:**

1. The length of the manuscript must not exceed 15 pages, inclusive of tables, illustrations and references.

2. Must be accompanied by a **separate cover letter** with every author(s) name, address, phone and fax numbers, e-mail, full affiliation and the track to which it is submitted. All correspondence will be sent to the first author unless otherwise specified.
3. Submitted papers must not currently be under review by any other publication or conference.
4. Submitters must provide their e-mail address where the acknowledgment will be forwarded.
5. All submissions **MUST** be submitted electronically in either **.doc (MS Word) format or .rtf (Rich Text) Format**. Please refer to **Notes to authors** (<http://www.gsim.aoyama.ac.jp/ibiz2007/notes2authors.doc>) for more detailed guidelines to facilitate the submission process.
6. Each paper must specify which conference track it belongs to. However, it may be switched to other tracks by the choice of the conference organizers to accommodate the publication needs. List of the conference tracks can be viewed here.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you do not receive an e-mail acknowledgment within two weeks after your electronic submissions, please contact the Program Chair at IBIZ2007@mmu.edu.my immediately.

**Accepted Manuscripts:**

Authors of accepted manuscripts and proposals will be asked to provide the final camera-ready copy of the submission in **MS Word or RTF format**. Authors of accepted papers (at least one person per submission) **MUST** register and attend the conference.

**Registration and Further Steps for the authors**

Author of accepted paper (at least one author) is required to register, attend and present the paper at the conference. The registration form is to be provided separately in January 2007.
